## IS MY SHORELINE PROJECT ELIGIBLE FOR THE PACKS PROGRAMMATIC?

Designing your project so that it is eligible for coverage under the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) PACKS (Projects Along Cushman and Kokanee Shorelines) Programmatic will significantly speed up your regulatory permitting process!

- Project involves bringing existing dock/pier/float into compliance with new structure requirements in the Cushman Shoreline Management Plan and associated Shoreline Use Specifications and Permitting Guidelines (SUSPG) Handbook).
- Project involves repair, replacement, or in-place maintenance of an existing bulkhead (shoreline stabilization).
- Project involves construction of a new shared dock (3 eligible lot minimum) where at least one existing dock structure will be removed.

Yes, your project may be eligible for coverage under the PACKS programmatic, so long as your project meets criteria for building materials, installation methods and timing, and does not include activities excluded from coverage; see details outlined in the PACKS Checklist for Overview and General CCMs.

- Project involves a new single-family dock/pier where one does not currently exist.
- Project involves a new bulkhead (structural shoreline stabilization) where one does not currently exist; or involves expansion of an existing bulkhead(s) greater than 10%.
- Project involves repair or maintenance of an existing structure that qualifies as a "prior existing use" but will not meet new structure requirements once repaired.

- Is it possible to change or adjust your project to meet the requirements of the PACKS?
- Please use the PACKS Checklists to help adjust and/or re-design your project.

If it is not possible to adjust or re-design your project to meet the requirements of PACKS; You will need to work directly with the Corps to determine your options.
